We are one of only a handful of AIDS agencies operating an on-site medical clinic, a full range of client support services, and a comprehensive HIV education and prevention program, including anonymous HIV testing.

In its 11,000 square mile service area, Desert AIDS Project serves more than 2,500 men, women and children affected by HIV/AIDS.
